Bible 4 credits	9 th -12 th grade students complete in-depth Bible studies to help them mature in their Christian lives. Studies include <i>Wise Up: Wisdom in Proverbs</i> , <i>The Life of Christ</i> , and <i>Route 66: Travel Through the Bible</i> .			
Spanish 2 credits	Secondary Spanish is a proficiency-based course designated to teach skills that involve vocabulary, listening, speaking, reading, and an introduction to the culture of Spanish-speaking people. Students will study practical vocabulary for daily communication, incorporating sound grammatical structure within both oral and written work. Spanish 1 and 2 as well as dual credit opportunities are available.			
Fine Arts 1 credit	Secondary Music students have a choice of participating in band or choir. Both programs emphasize development of the voice/instrument, music theory, music history, and music appreciation.			
	Secondary Drama students will explore the theater arts and have an opportunity to perform on stage.			
	Secondary Art class covers art appreciation and art history as well as two-dimensional and three-dimensional student created art.			
Physical Education 1 credit	Emphasis is on physical health through organized games and activities designed to meet the physical needs of every student.			
Athletics	Secondary students have the opportunity to participate in several athletics programs. LCA Athletic programs include football, baseball, volleyball, basketball, soccer, drill team, cross-country, and track.			
Communications ½ credit	Students will learn the fundamental skills of effective communication utilizing a Biblical worldview.			
Extracurricular Fine Arts	Extra-curricular Fine Arts Activities are available in class settings or private lessons through the LBEC Fine Arts Academy. Opportunities include handbells, tone chimes, and art as well as private instruction in voice, piano, trumpet, and clarinet.
